A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

We have so much to be grateful for here at Christ the King. We have a large and vibrant parish with so many wonderful families. I am continually overwhelmed by the kindness and generosity of the many people who call Christ the King home. Over the past 75 years, a lot has happened since those early days of having mass in an old army barracks with a handful of families. We outgrew that very quickly and since 1951 we have been in the same church building. While our parish has continued to grow, the size of the church has not, so much so that at half of our weekend masses, we have people standing in the back, the vestibule, or watching mass on TV in the chapel. Additionally like any older home, there are other issues that desperately need to be addressed. These range from an air conditioning system that is on its last legs, a woefully insufficient number of bathrooms, a sound system that needs to be replaced, inefficient lighting, and an organ console in need of significant repairs, as well as other behind the scenes problems. I come to you to request your prayers and support of the *Building Our Future Together* campaign to allow us to make these much needed renovations and improvements to our parish church.

As this is a once in a lifetime project, we want to make sure that our parish church continues to be a beautiful house of worship that accurately reflects our Catholic understanding of the centrality of the Eucharist, the full, active, and conscious participation of the faithful, and our belief in the communion of the saints. In addition to increasing the seating capacity from 640 to 1,000, we will be returning the tabernacle to its original place of prominence behind the altar. We will also be adding several new devotional areas (as voted on by the parishioners) in honor of St. John Paul II, St. Teresa of Kolkata, St. Joan of Arc, St. Ignatius Loyola, St. Martin of Tours (in honor of our military), and St. Jose Sanchez del Rio. Our new St. Michael's Courtyard will provide a beautiful gathering place before and after mass where we can spend time in fellowship and the new Gethsemane Garden will provide a place of reflection and prayer 24 hours a day.

Christ the King is our home. I hope that you will join me in this much needed expansion and upgrade so that we can make room for everyone to be welcomed in our home. This project will impact us all. It will be the church we come to on Sundays to be nourished by the Lord. It will be the church where your children and grandchildren get married, baptized and confirmed. It will be the church that we gather in to say goodbye to our loved ones. Please give prayerful consideration to making your pledge and join me in praying for the success of our campaign. The time has come to not just rest in our past accomplishments, but rather to continue **Building Our Future Together!**



The Scope of the Project

We all love our homes, but we also realize that sometimes they are in need of repair and updating. Our parish home is no different. The breakdown below explains the need of the improvements and repairs and the cost associated with them. Our plan is to begin construction on the church immediately following Easter which will enable us to be back in our church by Christmas.

CHURCH INTERIOR

When the current church was built in 1951 there were 500 families, currently we have over 3100 families, so it is easy to understand why the current seating capacity does not fit our needs! Currently the church seats 640. With the expansion we will be able to seat 1,000.

Another area where we are in much need of expansion are our restrooms. We will go from four single restrooms to a total of 10 large multi-stall functional restrooms.

The pipe organ, while still producing a majestic sound is in major need of repair. During the expansion the organ console will be removed, repaired upgraded and returned to an expanded choir loft. When the pipes were installed in 1990, it took up over one-third of the choir loft. With the expansion, the choir loft will now be able to comfortably accommodate our amazing choirs.

Our air-conditioning system has been on its last leg for longer than we would like to admit! The cost to replace our system alone is a six-figure cost and will be included in the expansion project.

The sound system is another area of the church that is barely hanging on and would also be a six-figure cost to be replaced. With the many audio/visual advances that have been made in recent years, the expansion will include upgrades to our entire sound system.

Our pews, which are over 65 years old, as well as the carpeting, lighting and electrical will all be upgraded.

An expansion to the church will afford us the opportunity for new devotional areas to St. John Paul II, St. Teresa of Kolkata, St. Joan of Arc, St. Ignatius Loyola, St. Jose Sanchez del Rio, St. Martin of Tours as well as a new narthex with new confessionals, brides' room and more efficient sacristies.

Total Cost: \$2,037,649

CHURCH EXTERIOR

In addition, the covered walkway and driveway will be expanded outward, allowing for a beautiful St. Michael's Courtyard where we will be able to hold Sunday Café and socialize after masses in our beautiful Florida weather.

Our church will literally have the side walls moved outward. The costs of the demolition of the walls (while preserving the marble) and moving our signature circular windows, along with construction materials, expenses and upgrades to all electrical and fire codes are included in this category.

Total Cost: \$1,962,351

TOTAL EXPANSION COST: \$4,000,000

Frequently Asked Questions

When will the work begin?

The work will begin as the funds become available from the *Building Our Future Together* campaign.

What will happen if we go over our goal?

All donations collected after we exceed our goal will be put towards the ongoing needs of the parish.

What if I never make a pledge?

Payments over time is common for large purchases. A pledge to the *Building Our Future Together* campaign is the same and makes it possible for you to make a more significant contribution than a one-time gift to the campaign without undue hardship.

Is my pledge over and above my Sunday Offering?

In short, yes. We can only reach our goal with a little extra sacrifice by our parish family. The parish will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period and reduction of Sunday Offerings would impact day to day operations of the parish.

Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

Every member of our parish family will be asked to consider a gift according to their financial ability. We pray everyone will play a conscientious role in renewing the future of the parish.

What happens if I am unable to fulfill my pledge?

Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If hardship or illness prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, simply let the parish know and other arrangements will be made.



Your Commitment

Stocks and Bonds

There are added advantages to giving stocks, bonds and securities. Not only will you receive credit for a charitable gift towards our campaign, you are also exempt from paying tax on the profit realized from the original investment if it has been held for more than one year. Please speak with your financial advisor for more information on making these types of charitable donations.

IRA Gifts

If you are over 70 1/2 years old, you may also be eligible to make a charitable gift from your IRA assets of up to \$100,000 per year with no tax complications. These types of gifts must be transferred directly and count toward your minimum required distribution. Again, it is always a good idea to speak with your financial advisor for more information.

Tax Deductible Gifts

All gifts are tax deductible as provided by law. Receipts will be provided for all gifts.

Wills and Bequests

What type of legacy will you leave? By remembering Christ the King in your will or making a bequest can leave a lasting legacy at our parish while also allowing you to contribute in a way you may not currently be able to. There are also significant federal and estate tax advantages through these gifts.

Matching Gift Programs

Many corporate firms have a matching gift program which provide incentives for their employees who make charitable donations. As the employee you will need to initiate the process and complete necessary paperwork. Both current and retired employees may be eligible. Please inquire with your human resources or personnel department for information about a matching gift program.
