## PROTOCOL FOR PUBLIC MASS

*Effective May 25, 2020*

1. Those who are feeling ill or at increased risk should not attend Mass.
2. Hand sanitizer stations will be located near all doors; attendees are strongly encouraged to sanitize their hands upon both entering and exiting the building.
3. Attendance will be limited to approximately 50% of church capacity in order to follow social distancing guidelines.
4. All weekend Masses will also be live-streamed to OLQA Chapel and McLoughlin Center to avoid crowding. Holy Communion will be brought to these locations.
5. Mass attendees should maintain a 6-foot distance from non-family members at all times and it is recommended that those attending wear face coverings.
6. All pews and commonly touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected before and after each Mass.
7. All hymnals have been removed from the church at this time. Music will be projected.
8. Seating in the church will be limited to every other pew.
9. To minimize the spread of any germs, collection baskets will not be passed, volunteers will hold baskets at the doors following weekend mass. Online giving is encouraged.
10. The faithful should not hold hands during the Lord's Prayer and the Sign of Peace will continue to be omitted.
11. Before and after Holy Communion, all those distributing Holy Communion will sanitize their hands.
12. Those in line for Communion should maintain 6-foot distance from non-family members.
13. Holy Communion will not be offered from the chalice.
14. Social distancing should be maintained by the faithful throughout campus, including doorways and in the parking lot.
15. Restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before and after each Mass.
