Anyone coming to Christ the King immediately notices the large number of families with children. We are blessed to have a very active and vibrant parish that is full of life and continues to grow. This growth has presented us with new challenges as we try to minster and take care of the needs of our children and youth. While our parish continues to expand, the truth is that we have a Youth Center (built as a bank in the 1950s) which we have outgrown and has no meaningful security. We have a cafeteria building, also built in the 1950s, with significant issues that need to be addressed, a nursey which is woefully too small, and no appropriate space for school musical and theatrical productions.

As your pastor, I take seriously the stewardship of your resources and cannot justify spending a significant amount of money just to maintain the status quo. Fortunately, we have a plan to address all these needs at once. I am pleased to announce our *Celebrate Youth* campaign in which we will demolish the current Cafeteria and construct a two-story building which will include a new Youth Center, Cafeteria/Kitchen, Nursery and Theater. The current Youth Center will be torn down to provide additional parking.

Our Finance Committee, Pastoral Council and School Advisory Board have studied our options and approved, with



the blessing of Bishop Parkes, this plan to build a new facility that will serve our parish, especially our young parishioners for generations to come. Christ the King is your home, your children's, and grandchildren's home. Please give prayerful consideration to making your pledge and join me in praying for the success of our campaign of this much needed project.




## **The Scope** of the Project

#### When will the work begin?

**Auditorium**

If you are over  $70\frac{1}{2}$  years old, you may be eligible to make a charitable gift from your IRA assets of up to \$100,000 per year with no tax complications. These types of gifts must be transferred directly and count toward your minimum required distribution. Again, it is recommended you speak with your financial advisor for more information.

#### **Tax Deductible Gifts**

All gifts are tax deductible as provided by law. Receipts will be provided for all gifts.

#### Is my pledge over and above Sunday Offering?

In short, yes. We can only reach our goal with a little extra sacrifice by our parish family. The parish will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period and reduction of Sunday Offerings would impact day to day operations of the parish.

#### Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

Every member of our parish family will be asked to consider a gift according to their financial ability. We pray everyone will play a conscientious role in renewing the future of the parish.

#### What if I am unable to fulfill my pledge?

Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If illness or hardship prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, simply let the parish know and other arrangements will be made.
